Jesus Came and Made a Way of Escape

I was in the television studio being interviewed by a couple who hosted the show. The host asked me, "Why does God send people to hell?" The answer I gave put a frightened look on their faces because they didn't expect the answer I gave and they didn't know what I would say next. I simply answered that **God doesn't send people to hell**. I went on to explain that in God's original creation of mankind we were made perfect. Adam was made in the image of God. He was made of God and he was just like God. Adam was as perfect as God was perfect, and pure as God was pure; he was a son of God. God walked with Adam and they had perfect fellowship together. God's holiness did not cause Adam to pull away because Adam was as pure as God was.

Adam was the seed of the entire human race and God's desire was for His son to reproduce billions and billions of people who had the same purity in their spirit. God wanted to walk and talk with every person that came into existence from this seed. It says in Genesis 2:7 "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being." This is the very moment that you and I also came into existence. The human race was born the moment Adam came to life and every single person has come from this one moment in time. Even when Eve was created; she did not come from God as Adam did. God took her beginning from Adam's DNA, from his rib. Genesis 2:22 "Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man." Every human born has come from the same seed. Please imagine an old train that is rolling down the tracks slow and steady. It is very long with millions of carriages that seem to go on forever. As smoke is billowing out from the chimney there are dusty hills and desert scenery all around it. If you follow the railroad tracks in front of the locomotive you will go miles and miles ahead. Suddenly the tracks disappear and go over a cliff that falls deep down into a pit of fire. Now, as you turn around and follow the tracks back to the train and as you get close enough you notice that the train has locks on all the doors. Every window has steel bars and written on every carriage are the word "human race". I want you to understand this image because the moment Adam and Eve sinned they placed themselves on the inside of this train, with no earthly way of escape. It was the nature of darkness that placed them on the train that will send the two of them into eternal

separation from God. Then they began to have children, born with the same nature of darkness, born inside the same train. A train with no escape that was moving steady and slowly to a cliff called death. Mankind has devised many schemes and has made many different attempts to escape from this train over the centuries but to no avail. Jesus came and made a way of escape from the train. He came into that train and made the first and only way off. He then invited each and every person to leave the Human race and to join a new family, "the family of God." This is what we call being born again. You were first born of your earthly parents but you are born out of them and into your Heavenly Family. The only way to escape the Human race and its drop into Hell is through Jesus as your savior.

Please read carefully where Jesus is talking to His disciples in Matthew 10:28-33 "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven."

Some people may think that this verse means to fear God who can send you to hell in a split second if you fail. That perception that God decides your fate on a daily basis is wrong. Today, you didn't do well enough, or you had a bad day, or you had a bad thought so now God will send you to Hell. But then tomorrow He might change His mind and choose to let you come to heaven. That is the complete opposite of what this scripture is saying. Look at how Jesus in the later verse tells them "Do not fear" and that God knows the number of hairs on their heads. Jesus is expressing the need for His disciples to become born again and that there is no way to get to God except through Jesus. Jesus is specifically talking to them about the need to leave the human race so they will never need to fear God. Once you are off the train God is not interested in placing you back on. You can choose to walk away from your Heavenly Father but He will never walk away from you. In fact scripture tells us that even though God is a judge, He is not the one responsible for where we end up. God did not send the human race to Hell. Adam did. God has been trying to rescue us ever since. As a judge, He will personally explain to each individual where they will spend eternity and carefully show them the proof of why. It says in Revelations 20:11-12 "Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books."

Are you born again? If you are then God is your Father and you are safe in His arms. He loves you and He believes in you. He thinks about you every moment of every day and even when you have a rough day, you never have to fear Him.
